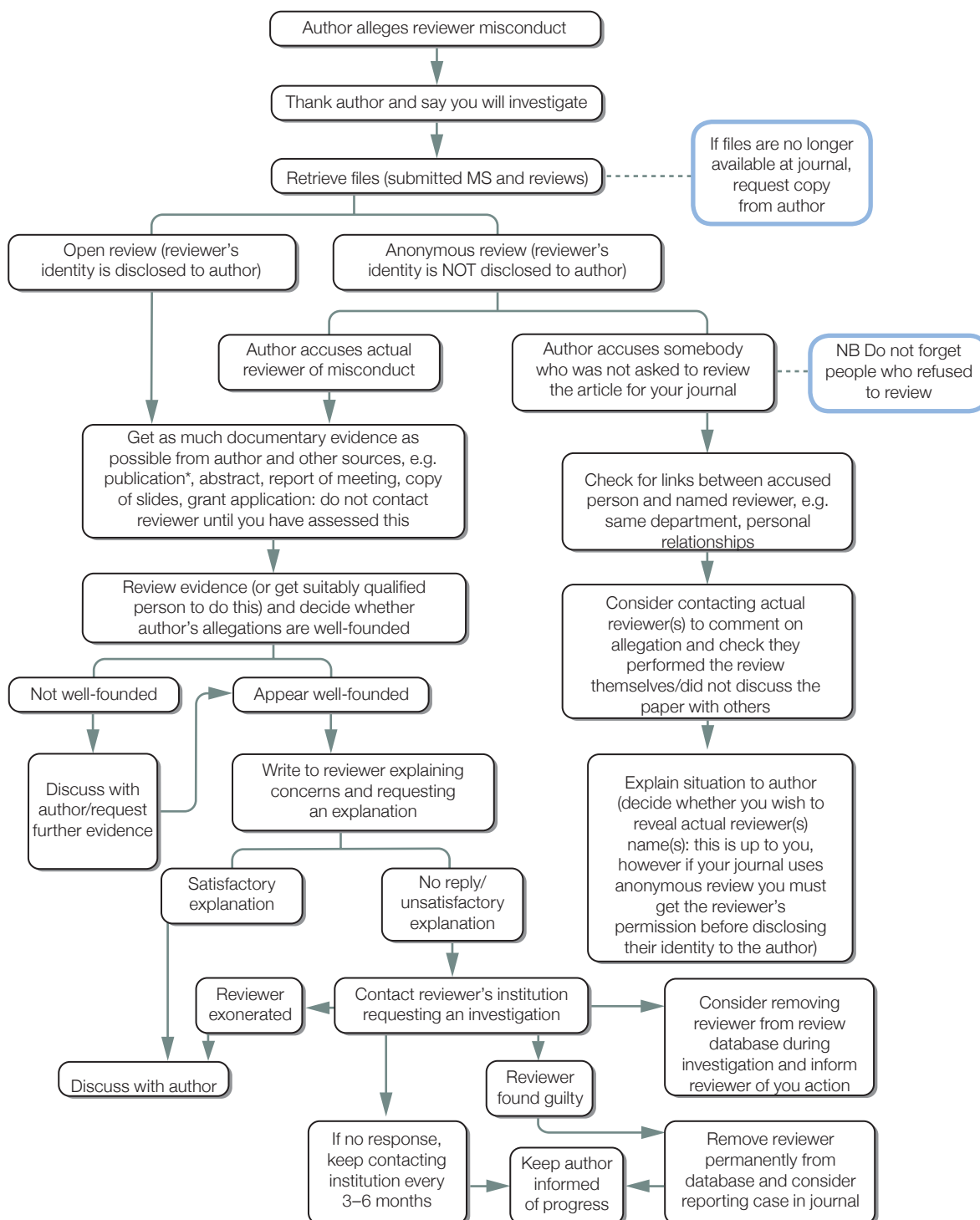
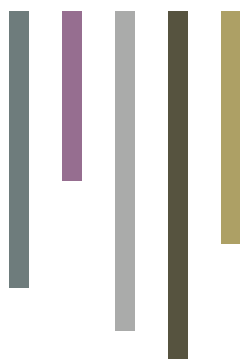


What to do if you suspect a reviewer has appropriated an author's ideas or data
